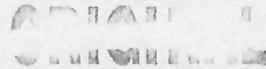

NARRATIVE On 07/08/20 at approximately 1710 hours, Corporal Carrillo #206 and I (Officer Roppo #219), were dispatched to the northwest corner of Mission Street and Fair Oaks Avenue regarding a verbal dispute between two female "Black Lives Matters" protesters and a male subject (who already fled the scene).

Upon arrival, I contacted V/Victoria Patterson, who told me the following in substance:

On 07/08/20 at approximately 1708 hours, Patterson was sitting by the corner of Fair Oaks Avenue on Mission Street where she and W/Fahren James had set up a "Black Lives Matter" protest booth. Patterson saw a male S' (unknown) on his bicycle having a verbal dispute with James. Patterson noticed S' was holding a rock in his hand, and out of concern she walked over to him and started video recording with her cellular phone. S' saw Patterson recording with her cellular phone, pulled his facemask down, and spat on her shirt. Patterson responded, "Fucking asshole. I'm going to call the cops!" S' rode away on his bicycle heading westbound on Mission Avenue.

S' was wearing a black hat, brown sunglasses, dark blue shirt, blue jean shorts, white socks, white Adidas shoes, silver large headphones, black gloves, and black backpack, holding a drum stick under his left armpit, riding a white bicycle.

I offered Patterson medical assistance and she declined. I asked Patterson if she was desirous of prosecution and she said, "Yes."

I then made contact with W/James and she told me the following in substance:

On 07/08/20 at approximately 1708 hours, she was standing on the northwest corner of Fair Oaks Avenue and Mission Street protesting for "Black Lives Matter." S' approached James, pointed at the Black Lives Matter signs, and said, "Is this you?" James responded, "Yes." S' said, "My Dad's a cop!" James responded, "My Dad's a cop, too!" S' said, "My Dad's dead!" and the two of them continued to argue.

S' got closer to James on his bicycle and she noticed S' had a rock in his hand. Patterson got up from the table and walked over to James. Patterson started recording the argument with her cellular phone.

At one point James told S', "You could go across the street. You could go wherever you gotta go. Nobody is holding you to stay here."

S' responded, "I'm going this way. I'm going to my neighborhood", as he pointed westward. James responded, "Okay now enjoy your day here." Patterson responded to S', "Now enjoy your day."

S' responded, "And you know what?" He pulled his facemask down, turned to Patterson, and spit on her shirt. *LIES*

James responded, "Fucking asshole! What the fuck is wrong with you! You do not spit on a woman! You do not spit on a woman!" (Video footage from Patterson's cellular phone has been uploaded in the system.) *Victor's*

Both Patterson and James can identify S' if seen again.

Officers searched the area and were unsuccessful in locating the suspect. A search for additional witnesses and /or evidence was unsuccessful.

Property/Evidence: Video footage uploaded to this report.

Disposition: To Detectives for review.
